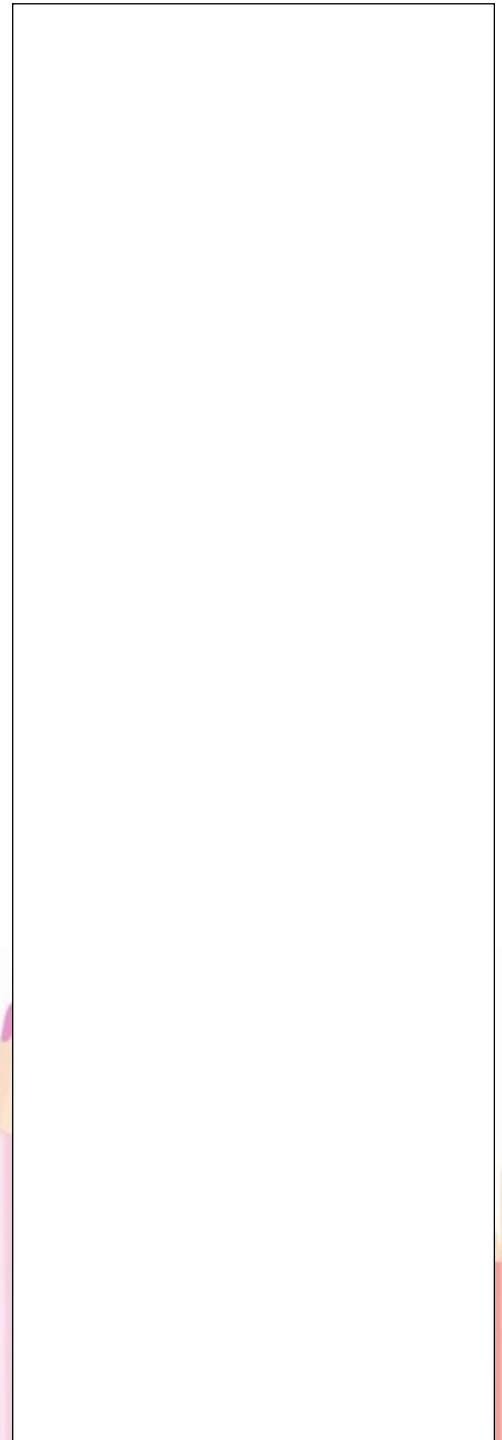


## Create-a-Bookmark Contest

  - Something from a favorite book (story, characters, theme, etc.)
- You can use your colored pencils, markers, crayons, finger paints or watercolors to create your bookmark. Please do not use stickers, stamps or stencils. Computer generated illustrations will be not accepted.
- All designs become the property of Comsewogue Public Library and cannot be returned. If you wish to have a copy of your bookmark, please be sure to make a photocopy for yourself before you submit your entry form.
- Teens, grades 6-12, can earn one hour of community service by submitting an entry!
- Winners will be announced in five different age/grade categories (PreK, gr. K-2, gr. 3-5, gr. 6-8 and gr. 9-12) on Sunday, April 7, 2019.
- Winning bookmarks will be reproduced and distributed throughout the library for a limited time, beginning Sunday, April 7, 2019.
