

Comsewogue Public Library Early Voting Application

(for Library Elections, Budget Votes and Referenda)

This application may only be used for Comsewogue Public Library (CPL) votes/elections by registered voters who reside in the Comsewogue School District. If the applicant requests that the early voting ballot be mailed, the application must be received by CPL's administration office not later than 7 days before the vote/election (by 5 p.m.) for which the early voting ballot is sought. Otherwise, the application may be personally delivered to CPL's administration office not later than the day before the election (by 5 p.m.). Applications may not be submitted more than 30 days prior to the election. If you are qualified for early voting and issued an early voting ballot, the ballot itself must be received by CPL's administration office by 5 p.m. on the day of the vote/election in order for it to be canvassed.

Application for Early Voter/Absentee Ballot Instructions

Early Voter/Absentee ballots may be used by eligible voters* for voting on the Library's budget and trustee election. Applications may be obtained by contacting the Office of the Clerk of the Comsewogue Public Library or by download from our website.

The Library must receive applications at least seven (7) days prior to the vote/election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter or by 5:00 p.m. on the day prior to the vote/election if the ballot is to be personally delivered to the voter.

Persons designated as "permanently disabled" by the Suffolk County Board of Elections are entitled to receive an absentee ballot without making separate application for such absentee ballot.

Ballots must be received in the Office of the Clerk of the Comsewogue Public Library no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day of the election in order to be counted.

*Eligible Voters are:

- 1. At least 18 years of age.
- 2. Citizens of the United States.
- 3. Residents of the Comsewogue School District for at least thirty days preceding the vote.
- 4. Registered to vote (you are registered to vote if you have voted within the last four years in a general, school or library election).
