## WHAT IS 1000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN?

It's a free program that encourages you to read 1000 books with your child before they start kindergarten. It's easy, fun, and a great way to bond with your young child. The time before a child enters kindergarten is crucial for language and brain development, as well as for fostering a lifelong love of reading. Although 1000 sounds like a lot – just one book a day adds up fast!

## HOW IT WORKS

1. Read together: Any book counts!
2. Track your books: Use our paper reading log.
3. Celebrate milestones: Add a sticker to your log for every 100 books read and get a certificate at 500!
4. Finish strong: When you reach 1000 books, your child gets a medal and is added to our Wall of Fame!

## WHY JOIN?

- Helps your child develop early literacy skills.
- Encourages a lifelong love of reading.
- Builds strong family connections through shared reading.
- Prepares your child for academic success.

## HOW TO START

- Sign up in-person at the Children's Reference Desk and receive your log and a book to start your reading journey.

## FAQS

- Who can join? Any child who has not yet entered kindergarten is eligible to participate (Comsewogue cardholders only)

- Do books have to come from the library? We encourage it, but any book counts!
